This week we are learning about 'Advent and the Nativity'. The children will be learning about the celebration, discovering how and why people celebrate, with a particular emphasis on the story of Jesus. The children will be participating in fun activities to support their learning including making a creating personalised cards, making advent calendars and participating in traditional, celebratory games. This week in phonics, we finish Phase 2 Phonics. The children will be recapping all of the sounds they have learnt since September. We will be reading CVC words that the children may have found difficult over the last term. The children will also be taking part in their termly phonics assessments. If you have misplaced the sheets, please ask your class teacher for more support.
